Based on compositional information provided by the companies that supply the individual components of the labels, and on the currently available toxicity data on these components, evaluated to February 2010, it is our opinion that the occasional accidental ingestion of one of these labels is unlikely to present any significant toxicological risk to the healthy consumer.
